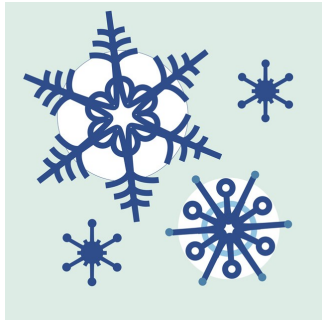




Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program

Northern Kentucky Community Action Commission helps low income individuals and families develop the knowledge, opportunities, and resources they need to achieve self reliance.



LIHEAP Crisis program will begin on Wednesday, January 4, 2012. Households will need to be income eligible as well as meet the crisis definition for their primary heat source. Households that heat with electric or natural gas will require a disconnect notice. Households that heat with a bulk fuel (propane or heating fuel) will need to be within 4-5 days of running out. Applications will be taken on a first come, first served basis. The Pendleton County Neighborhood Center reserves the right to limit the number of families served daily.

- 1) PHOTO IDENTIFICATION FOR HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS AGE 18 AND OVER
- 2) SOCIAL SECURITY CARDS FOR ALL HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS
- 3) PREVIOUS MONTH'S PAY STUBS AND/OR AWARD LETTER FOR STATE/FEDERAL BENEFITS RECEIVED
- 4) CURRENT RENT RECEIPT OR PROOF OF HOME OWNERSHIP
- 5) DISCONNECT NOTICE FOR METERED UTILITY IF ELECTRIC OR NATURAL GAS*
- 6) LAST DELIVERY TICKET FOR BULK FUEL DELIVERIES

***Household's with a disconnect notice may apply for benefits within 5 days of the stated date on the disconnect notice.**

Please note that staff will be required to verify disconnect status and/or recent deliveries on all accounts.
